// Opposing Solo

Lieutenant Commander Andre Webb is a native of Lawton, Oklahoma, and graduated from Lawton Eisenhower High School in 2004, where he lettered in football. He attended the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Economics in 2008, and earned his commission as an Ensign in the U.S. Navy.

Andre reported to Naval Air Station (NAS) Pensacola, Florida, for aviation indoctrination training in July 2008. He completed Primary flight training in the T-34C Turbo Mentor at NAS Corpus Christi, Texas, in July 2009. He subsequently completed Intermediate and Advanced flight training in the T-45C Goshawk at NAS Kingsville, Texas, and earned his wings of gold in December 2010.

Andre then reported to Marine Fighter Attack Training Squadron (VFMAT) 101, the “Sharpshooters,” at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, in January 2011 for initial training in the F/A-18 Hornet. In June 2012 he reported to the “Valions” of Strike Fighter Squadron (VFA) 15 at NAS Oceana, Virginia. While there, he served as the Schedules Officer, Line Division Officer, Aircraft Division Officer, Landing Signals Officer and Air-to-Ground Weapons and Tactics Officer. Andre completed a deployment aboard USS George H.W. Bush (CVN 77) in support of Operations Inherent Resolve, Freedom’s Sentinel, and Enduring Freedom. Andre then reported to the “Golden Eagles” of Training Squadron (VT) 22 at NAS Kingsville, in July 2015 as an instructor pilot where he also served as the Student Control Officer and International Military Student Officer.

Andre joined the Blue Angels in September 2017. He has accumulated more than 2,400 flight hours and 200 carrier arrested landings. His decorations include two Strike Flight Air Medals, the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and various other unit and personal awards.
