PRINCIPAL PURPOSE: The purpose of this screening is to obtain biographical data from applicants in order to aid in the determination of qualified candidates into the Navy Flight Demonstration Squadron Backseat Rider Program Key Influencer Program with the U.S. Navy Blue Angels. Information will be used by the squadron's events staff through the period of pre-vetting and flight to ensure applicants meet the age requirement for the flight and to assist in contacting applicants for coordination throughout the planning process.

ROUTINE USES: Those disclosures generally permitted under 5 U.S.C. 552a(b) of the Privacy Act, information contained will not be disclosed outside the DoD. This screening sheet will be destroyed at the conclusion of the flight.

DISCLOSURE: Disclosure is voluntary; however, failure by an applicant to provide the information may result in delay or possible rejection of the individual's application to the Navy Flight Demonstration Squadron Backseat Rider Program with the U.S. Navy Blue Angels.

 - Their **CURRENT** community involvement.
 - Nominee's area of impact (i.e., location(s), age groups, overall number of people, etc.).

Key Influencer is defined as people who help to shape attitudes and opinions of youth in their communities. People turn to Key Influencers for advice and information because they have credibility. They may be experts in their field, public figures, leaders of youth organizations, teachers, guidance counselors, or school administrators. They are not always the person at the top of an organization, but have a strong impact on recruiting age youth and/or a specific target audience. Good examples of local community Key Influencers include: university presidents, area organizers of youth athletics, society award winners, school board members, high school principals, coaches, and leaders of diversity groups. Flying these deserving candidates, in cooperation with media presence, will promote the Navy and Marine Corps as professional and exciting organizations with which to serve. **Elected officials, freelance reporters, and photographers are NOT eligible.**

When considering Key Influencer nominees, it is important to include examples of community service and youth involvement that may help a candidate stand out amongst other nominees. People involved with organizations such as Boys and Girls clubs, community athletic clubs, Big Brother & Big Sisters, Police Explorers, band leaders, etc. are good examples of personnel who stand out as quality Blue Angels Key Influencers. These people should currently have regular interaction with youth within their community, which means the influence they provide in a youth's life will have a **lasting and significant impact**. It cannot be overstated that nominees must **currently** be doing these great things. The ultimate goal of the Blue Angels Key Influencer Program is to promote a culture of excellence within the community and inspire youth to work hard towards achieving their goals. Flying these well-deserved candidates promotes not only the Navy and Marine Corps, but the culture of excellence the Blue Angels strive to uphold.

PLEASE NOTE: If your nominee has flown with the Blue Angels or any other military organization in the past, they will not be eligible. All selections are contingent upon final medical approval by our Blue Angels Flight Surgeon.
