Master Chief Avionics Technician(AW) Robby Bonanno, a native of Honolulu, Hawaii, and attended Clark High School in Las Vegas. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in February 1987 and completed Navy basic training at Recruit Training Command San Diego.

Robby completed Aviation Electrician's Mate "A" School in Millington, Tennessee, and reported to Naval Air Station (NAS) North Island for ASN-50 Automatic Heading Reference System Fleet Readiness Aviation Maintenance Personnel training.

Robby has served with Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Department NAS Barbers Point, Kapolei, Hawaii; Strike Fighter Squadron 97 (VFA-97), the "Warhawks;" Electronic Attack Squadron 34 (VAQ-34), the "Flashbacks;" Strike Fighter Squadron 137 (VFA-137), the "Kestrels;" and Naval Aviation Maintenance Training Detachment Lemoore, California.

Robby returned to VFA-137 in September 2000, where he was promoted to Chief Petty Officer. He also served at NAS Patuxent River, Maryland, and in 2004, returned to NAS Lemoore, to Strike Fighter Squadron 14 (VFA-14), the "Tophatters," where he was promoted to Senior Chief Petty Officer.

Robby reported to Strike Fighter Squadron 125 (VFA-125), the "Rough Raiders," and advanced to Master Chief Petty Officer in 2010. He reported to Strike Fighter Squadron 25 (VFA-25), the "Fist of the Fleet," as the Maintenance Master Chief Petty Officer (MMCPO) in July 2010.

Robby joined the Blue Angels in October 2013. His decorations include three Navy Commendation Medals, five Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals, and various personal and unit awards.
